

## Railroads through Watkins Glen

From a 1929 brochure:

Watkins Glen is served by four railroad systems and an interurban trolley road leading to Elmira.

The Pennsylvania railroad has excellent yard and freight house equipment in the village and a fine passenger station.

The attractive station of the Pennsylvania division of the New York Central is at the head of Watkins Glen, through which thousands of excursionists pass each year.

The Lehigh Valley's main line is one mile east of the village.

The Erie railroad furnishes excellent daily freight service to this community.
